



# Two major species in Southeastern U.S.

• Rabbiteye blueberries (Vaccinium ashei)

• Southern highbush (Vaccinium hybrids)

## Rabbiteye Advantages

- Later flowering time
- More vigorous plants
- Grow better on upland soils; require less organic matter
- More heat and drought tolerant
- Firmer fruit
  - Possible machine harvest even for fresh market
  - More suitable for long distant shipping

# Southern highbush advantages

- Ripen early
- Generally larger berry size
- Most varieties are self fruitful whereas rabbiteye varieties are not
- Typically smoother textured berry

# Georgia Rabbiteye vs SHB

• Early 1990's acreage of SHB was < 1%.

• Late 1990's maybe up to 10% SHB.


• Currently, 30% or more SHB.

### Fresh vs. Processed

 Most of 1990's was around 25% fresh 75% processed.

• In last few years, has been more nearer 50% fresh and 50% processed.

#### **UGA Blueberry Breeding Program History**



- Dr. W. Thomas
  Brightwell really gave
  the program a boost in
  1945, when 25 acres of
  land in south Georgia
  near Alapaha was
  dedicated to blueberry
  cultivar development.
- First 5 decades, primarily bred rabbiteye blueberries, but now also very active in southern highbush cultivar development.

# **Today**

- Program occupies about 50 acres of land at Alapaha where chill hours are 600 to 700 per year.
- About 12 acres at Griffin, where chill hours are 1100 to 1200 per year.










# Blueberry Cultivar Development Timeline









- Late season (later than Tifblue and Powderblue)
- Blooms late, ripens late
- Medium to large size
- Less rain splits than Tifblue
- 650 chill hours
