Primocane-Fruiting (PF) Raspberries

- Primocane-fruiting raspberries produce fruit at the top of first-year canes in late summer.
- If allowed to overwinter, these same canes will produce fruit again in early summer of the second year.

Primocane-Fruiting (PF) Raspberries

 Most growers sacrifice the early summer second-year crop in favor of late-summer primocane crop. Therefore, the primocanes can be cut to the ground mechanically, resulting in a single crop of fruit.

High Tunnel Raspberry in Virginia

- High tunnel grown raspberry have shown to be a profitable niche crop for small growers, averaging \$3.00 for a ½ pint clamshell
- In Virginia, depending on the region, primocane crop starts in mid-June to July and it continuous in some regions until mid December.
- Floricane crop starts in mid-May until mid-July











Average yield/plant/harvest (grams) for primocane crop (single crop) of four different raspberry cultivars under high tunnel, Petersburg, VA, 2013




